What are “Allowable” uses for this fund? (not an extensive list)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• At least one-third for evidence-based, structured literacy interventions that have been shown to improve reading and writing achievement of students• At least one-third for evidence-based mathematics instruction and interventions, including educational programming intended to improve career and college readiness at at-risk students, dual or concurrent enrollment, and career and technical education and• No more than one-third on the following interventions:<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Case management, tutoring and after-school and summer enrichment programs that are delivered by social workers, counselors, teacher or other professional staff• Culturally relevant professional and curriculum development, including those necessary to support language acquisition and bilingual and multicultural education• Whole school interventions, including social and emotional learning programs, MLSS, Student nutrition programs, school-based health center and community schools.• Instructional resources and materials• Services to engage and support parents and families in the education of students; and• Services to engage and support tribal communities in the education of Native American students.
Requirements:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Schools must tell PED about their plans for spending and report student outcomes.
