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| What is the Purpose of this fund? | The Student Support and Academic Enrichment (SSAE) grant is Title IV Part A of the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA), and targets three areas that may affect outcomes for student subpopulations: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Well-rounded education, (at least 20% of budget) 2. Safe and health students, and (at least 20% of budget) 3. Effective use of technology (amount greater than zero) <p>The SSAE funding is apportioned based on the number of students from low-socio economic status.</p> |
| What is included in the BPS Grant Application? | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Well-rounded education – After school enrichment activities and clubs. This could include, but is not limited to STEAM/STEM club, CTE Club, Coding/Robotics Club, SEL (Social Emotional Learning) Club. (Additional Comp and General Supplies) 2. Safe and Health Students - SEL Initiatives and Restorative Practices Professional Development: Staff will participate in SEL and restorative justice best practices. They will also learn about trauma informed instruction. These trainings will provide resources to make our schools more positive and productive for students and staff. (Professional Development) 3. Effective use of Technology – Enrichment/CTE professional development to inform instruction and support collaboration in Tier 1. (Professional Development) |

You MUST also include an agenda and sign in sheet. (Use Impact Aid or At-Risk funds, if available) • Clothing is not allowed (School shirts, etc.) • Gift Cards or other incentives |
